An Unprecedented Initiative

or centuries, the Society of Jesus, inspired by St. Ignatius Loyola, has responded to the call of Christ to proclaim the Word of God with responsiveness and flexibility. These remain important tenets in the lives of Jesuits today, who continue the important mission of helping men and women of all ages to experience lives of faith, hope and love.

Continuing this vital mission—the service of faith that does justice—the USA Northeast Province proposes an exceptional fundraising effort—the first of its type in our new region—with a projected cost of \$14 million to address critical improvements:

- † Creating the Jesuit Center, maximizing our response to increased apostolic needs
- † Transforming the St. Ignatius Loyola Community on New York City's East 83rd Street

Campaign at a Glance ▶ The Jesuit Center...Project Cost \$14 million

The Jesuit Center will transform two existing buildings into an environment that inspires collaboration among Jesuits and lay colleagues. As the central administrative office of the future USA East Province, which will span from Maine to Georgia in 2020, the Jesuit Center will be home to more than 40 staff members who will respond to crucial apostolic, spiritual and social needs. To accommodate this growth, the Jesuit Center project will include:

- Completely transforming the St. Ignatius Loyola Jesuit Community
- Renovating 16 new bedrooms
- The creation of six new office spaces
- Constructing two chapels for community and staff use
- · Adding seven conference center guest suites
- New kitchen, dining and library areas
- Energy-efficient windows and electrical upgrades; new elevator
- Enhanced conference space with technology upgrades
- A garden area for gathering, reflection and relaxation

The Jesuits of the USA Northeast Province have been blessed with vast opportunities to serve Christ and join in His mission. Gifts to this capital campaign will underwrite the design, construction and implementation of the new Jesuit Center. This fundraising initiative marks the first time donors have had the opportunity to create an important apostolic center that will shape the future of Jesuit ministries throughout the eastern United States.


An Apostolic Center that Inspires Collaboration

Since 1954, the St. Ignatius Loyola Jesuit Community on New York's 83rd Street has been the home to as many as 70 Jesuits. Some changed the lives of students at Regis High School and Loyola School and served the spiritual needs of parishioners at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish. Others accompanied the sick and dying in hospitals that stood on the islands along New York's East River. Still others had important roles as part of the provincial's administrative team, sustaining the Ignatian mission of the schools, colleges, universities, parishes and retreat centers—all of the places where people still actively engage and encounter Jesuits.

The demand for Jesuit ministries in the Northeast has withstood the test of time, but critical improvements to the province offices and the St. Ignatius Loyola Jesuit Community are needed to support Jesuits and their colleagues as they stand ready to continue shaping the future of our remarkable Ignatian works.


In 2020, when the Jesuits of the U.S. and Canada complete a planned strategic reorganization, Jesuit works from Maine to Georgia will be united as part of the new USA East Province. In all, more than 60 ministries—benefiting thousands of men, women and families both in the eastern United States and internationally—will be administered from the Jesuit Center on East 83rd Street in Manhattan.

With the creation of the USA East Province in 2020, the number of Jesuit works administered from the province office in New York City will be more than twice what it was in 1960.
